BOND REFERENDUM

ON THE BALLOT: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2025



On **Tuesday, November 4, 2025**, Bedford CSD residents will consider approving an \$11.5 million general obligation bond referendum. These funds would allow the district to construct a **new competition gymnasium and loading dock** at the secondary school.

These are the next major items identified by the district's **Master Facilities Plan.** The main gym is approximately **40 years old** and cannot accommodate current programming and activity needs due to its size, capacity, and other challenges. The secondary gym is nearly **a century old** (pictured) and used mostly as multipurpose space due to its age, safety concerns, and small size.

A comparison of school districts in our region shows that Bedford CSD trails its peers when it comes available gyms and seating capacity.
